GELO 5 Awareness


Show that they are aware of local, regional and global issues, and construct informed and thoughtful responses to these issues;



Period of Study

GELS and PAVE Courses:

To be taken from Year 1 Semester 2 onwards (NO pre-requisite)

• GEIC:

To be taken <u>from Year 2 Semester 2 to Year 3 Semester 1</u>
Pre-requisite - any GELS or PAVE Course (but NO pre-requisite for Senior Year Entry students)

Students are required to complete all GEBCs (9 cps) before taking the University ePortfolio Course

Students can choose to take GEBCs in the Summer Semester

University ePortfolio (UePortfolio)

3-cps course Level 4 Students are required to take any one of the University ePortfolio courses developed by departments and GEO

Lectures

Attend a couple of lectures at the beginning of the course to acquire skills for reflective thinking and writing

Period of Study*

BEd/DD students and Senior Entrants:
Year 4 Sem 1

Non-BEd students: Year 3 Sem 2

Study Groups

Meet with the course supervisors and the fellow group-members in consultation sessions for reflective writing and preparing individual University ePortfolios

Period of Study

Non-BEd Senior Year Entry students:	Year 4 Semester 1

Remarks:

Students should take UePortfolio (courses) in the assigned semester of study. UePortfolio (courses) should not be taken in parallel with HP/ BP though these could be done in parallel with ELC/ CSLC if necessary.

- Faculties and departments are encouraged to revise the existing GEBCs (Strands 1-3) and existing CSLCs into ELCs or develop new ELCs according to the course development guidelines.
- Course development guidelines and forms/ templates will be provided by AVP(SL) and/or GEO in due course.
