Preparation for University ePortfolio

You will take University ePortfolio (UePortfolio) after completion of all General Education Breadth Courses required. Students have to take the UePortfolio in the year of study assigned by individual programmes. You could go a bit further from now on – start building your UePortfolio by keeping electronic (soft) copies of all your artefacts or evidence of the GE Foundation Course and the GE Breadth Courses in addition to the other learning experience of your undergraduate studies such as those from Major, Minor, elective courses, internship, overseas learning and field experience for potential inclusion in the UePortfolio. When building your ePortfolio, you should refer to the General Education Learning Outcomes (GELOs) which embody the graduate attributes of EdUHK. Based on the records and artefacts, you need to reflect on your learning and critically analyse what and how improvement can be done for future personal development.



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
